ructing this Reference is made to Bureau teletype of office to submit a memorandum for receipt at the Bureau by May 8 containing a list of wisitors received by LUCIANO at Dannemora during the wartime period.

Some delay has been incurred in obtaining this information inasmuch as it was ascertained at Dannemora that LUCIANO was transferred from Dannemora to Great Meadows Prison, Comstock, New York during the early part of the war, and further investigation at Great Meadows Prison reflected that he had subsequently been transferred to Sing Sing at Ossining, Hew York, which is within the New York Field Division. All information with reference to visitors of LUCIANO at Dannemora is contained in his file at Sing Sing.
